


Set #1 Counts: 0 Measures: opening set


F- Flute, C- Clarinet, A- Alto Sax, R- Tenor Sax ,BS - Bari Sax


Set #2 Counts: 32 Measures: 1-8

Band should be dancing and having a great time as they travel to their dots. The dance could really start from anywhere. just be in this dot by count 32




Set #3 Counts: 32 Measures: 9-16

HOLD for strong opening			




Set #4 Counts: 16 Measures: 17-20

Move 16		




Set #5 Counts: 16 Measures: 21-24

Move 16, T2 should stay behind Low winds as they come in to circle type arc




Set #6 Counts: 16 Measures: 25-28

Set #7 Counts: 16 Measures: 29-32


Move to set16




Set #7A Counts: 4 Measures: 33

Maybe a crab type step or a grapevine idea.




Subset is second part of move. Lines go the opposite way for 8 counts






Set #11 Counts: 16 Measures: 45-48

Move to arcs 16




Set #12 Counts: 32 Measures: 49-56
